

# MT WILHELM TREK

**PNG's Highest Mountain, 14,775 feet (4509 metres)  
From 4 Days/3 Nights to 3 Days/2 Nights:**

The ascent of Mt. Wilhelm is a strenuous though non technical climb. Drive from Mount Hagen through the fertile Wahgi Valley and the spectacular Simbu Gorge to Kegsugl at 8200 feet (2500 metres), and our accommodation for the night. Next morning a moderate four hour climb through rainforest and alpine grasslands to the Piunde Lakes base camp at 11,700 feet (3600 metres). One can spend an easy day here enjoying the superb views, alpine grasslands, glacial lakes and waterfalls, or take a longer hike to the WW2 wreck of a B17 bomber. Those wishing to conquer the summit head off pre-dawn aiming for the summit at sunrise, and incredible views of the north coastline and surrounding mountains and valleys. Return to the base camp in the afternoon. Next morning hike to Kegsugl and return to Mount Hagen or Goroka.

## **Itinerary;**

**Day 1:** (-LD) Guided trek to PNG's highest mountain. Depart Mt. Hagen or Goroka by 4WD vehicle to Kegsugl via Pari burial caves. On arrival, afternoon tour of Betty's Trout farm, bird watching and nearby forests. Overnight Betty's Lodge.

**Day 2:** (BLD) Early morning after breakfast, trek/climb to Base Camp. Afternoon explore the lakes Piunde Yaundo, nature, flora and fauna. Overnight at the A FRAME Hut.

**Day 3:** (BLD) Early morning, pre-dawn climb from base camp to the summit. Enjoy sunrise at the top and magnificent views before returning to Base Camp for overnight at A FRAME Hut or to Kegsul at Betty's Lodge.

**Day 4:** (BL-) Depart Kegsugl and take breathtaking scenery drive through gorges, fast flowing rivers, alpine forests and grass lands to Mt. Hagen or Goroka. ***End of Mt. Wilhelm Trek.***
