

SEPIK RIVER CANOEING

5 days/ 4 nights to 4 Days/3 Nights (Must operate Monday to Friday or vv)

The environment has been described as *"raw and primitive"*, but for the traveler with an adventurous spirit, it is adventure "par excellence". Travel in this region is by motorized dugout canoe, exploring the main waterways and smaller channels, visiting traditional villages, sleeping in village houses and experiencing the lifestyle and culture of these river people. This area is renowned as the finest source of primitive art in the world. Sepik art is valued not only for its beautiful workmanship and aesthetic appeal, but also as a cultural statement. The art of the Sepik people enhances an understanding of the culture and values of the Sepik people. Their art is a visual language.

Itinerary;

Day 1: (-LD) Depart Wewak by MAF light aircraft to Ambunti. Arrive in Ambunti by light aircraft for transfer by dug out motorized canoe travel to Maliwe, Meno, and Tongjamb villages. Return to Meno village and overnight there.

Day 2: (BLD) Depart Meno village by dugout motorized canoe to Yambon village and Wagu lakes. Return to Ambunti, and then travel on to Korogo and Palimbe villages. Overnight at Palimbe village.

Day 3: (BLD) Depart Palimbe by dugout motorized canoe to Kanganamun, Aibom and Chambri lakes explore area and their vicinities. Overnight Krimbit village.

Day 4: (BLD) Depart Krimbit village by dugout motorized canoe for a full days trip to Ambunti. Rest of the day is free. Overnight Ambunti Lodge.

Day 5: (B--) Depart Ambunti Lodge by dugout motorized canoe to Ambunti airstrip for light MAF flight to Wewak..
