Tari Valley Huli Trek - From 5 days/4 nights moderate trek to 3 Days/2 Nights

Isolated by geography and history, the Huli people of the Tari Valley were one of the last groups in Papua New Guinea to be brought under government control. The Huli Wigmen are noted for their flamboyant and colorful appearance, beautifully painted faces, and their use of bird of paradise feathers and everlasting daisies to decorate their wigs of human hair. This is a male dominated society concerned with maintaining the strength and status of the male. Separation of men and women in village life is an integral part of their culture. A complex society in which land and rights to land are of importance and the cause of much tribal warfare. So you will gain a genuine insight into this society still governed by sorcery and ancestral spirits in its everyday activities.

Day 1: (-LD) On arrival at Tari airport, meet by local guide for transfer by PMV, Public Motor Vehicle to Warili Village. Welcome by Huli wigmen and enjoy an evening earth oven prepared (mumu) dinner. Overnight Warili Lodge.

Day 2: (BLD) Depart Warili village by trek/hike after breakfast with your local guide to Hudi village. Visit Huli tribe burial grounds. Overnight Hudi Village Guest House.

Day 3: (BLD) Depart Hudi village by trek/hike to Kakanalu village. Visit Huli bachelors and Huli widows. Overnight Kakanalu Village Guest House.

Day 4: (BLD) Depart Kakanalu village by trek/hike to Paragua village. Visit Kakanalu spirit dancers, medicine men and ceremonial grounds. Overnight Paragua Village Guest House.

Day 5: (B--) Depart Paragua village for Tari airport by PMV. On arrival, transit to Air Niugini flight PX866 to Port Moresby. End of Huli Valley Trek.
