Tari Valley Huli Moderate Trek - Isolated by geography and history, the Huli people of the Tari Valley were one of the last groups in Papua New Guinea to be brought under government control. The Huli Wigmen are noted for their flamboyant and colorful appearance, beautifully painted faces, and their use of bird of paradise feathers and everlasting daisies to decorate their wigs of human hair.
